Toplink had a useful drop-and-create-tables options which made unit testing a lot easier because you always new you were testing a fresh database. Well, I've been trying to do the same thing in OpenJPA and couldn't figure it out until I found this JIRA issue: <u>OPENJPA-94</u>.

The nearest equivalent in OpenJPA is the following obscure setting:

```
openjpa.jdbc.SynchronizeMappings=buildSchema(SchemaAction='add,deleteTableConte
```

It is actually faster than the Toplink method because the tables aren't recreated, they are just updated and emptied. It'd just be nice if it had a sensible name, and appeared in the docs somewhere!
