

## **Samsung Firmware Downloads**

For your convenience, here are all the files you need and some basic instruction to flash your Samsung Galaxy Spica i5700. This page is not meant to be a tutorial, just a handy reference.

[SAMSUNG\\_USB\\_Driver\\_for\\_Mobile\\_Phones.exe](#)

[Odin 4.03](#) Flash original firmware to your phone.

[spica\\_jc3.ops](#) Needed when you flash with Odin.

[I5700XXJH6.zip](#) Original firmware for Android 2.1.

[i5700\\_LK2-08\\_PDA.tar](#) Patched Root Kernel which fixes VoIP.

The basic flashing procedure is:

1. Install USB Drivers and unzip firmware
2. Disconnect USB cable
3. Start phone in download mode (Vol Down + Camera + Power)
4. Connect USB cable
5. Start Odin as Administrator
6. Select spica\_jc3.ops and original firmware package
7. Flash and test your phone
8. Flash the rooted kernel which includes recovery mode

Once the new kernel is installed, use Vol Down + Call + Power to enter recovery mode to install ROMs packaged as .zips.
